Solution[™]7 is a 100% solution dyed polyester and is the best fabric to provide your boat with the protection it deserves. Solution dyed means that the color is actually added to the polyester before the yarns are even spun, therefore the color will not wash out. Solution[™]7 was specifically developed for the marine industry, and has now become the choice fabric for many of the highest quality boats manufactured today. Solution[™]7 has been designed to completely eliminate the need for fluorocarbon finishes. Solution[™]7 has a bio-based finish called Teflon EcoElite[™]. This material was developed due to increasing environmental regulations and brings the marine industry one step closer to minimizing our carbon footprint. Teflon EcoElite[™] biobased finish is three times more durable than traditional flurocarbon finishes and enhances the quality of this marine-grade fabric with less environmental impact. The Solution[™]7 warranty covers the fabric from becoming unserviceable due to loss of color or strength due to normal usage and conditions. The customer is responsible for routine care and cleaning.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Solution[™]7 is designed to be easy to maintain. It can be washed, or brushed off and rinsed. Proper care and cleaning is important to the life of the fabric. Keeping your cover and top clean is the only way to prevent mold and mildew. For normal care and cleaning add two ounces of mild soap to one gallon of lukewarm water. Clean the fabric with a soft bristle brush. Rinse thoroughly with cold water and air dry. Applying 303 Fabric Guard after cleaning once a year will increase the water resistance and extend the life of the cover. For stubborn stains or mold add one cup of bleach to one gallon of water and follow the same cleaning instructions. Prolonged exposure to harsh chemicals can damage the fabric so rinse immediately. Cleaning with harsh chemicals such as bleach will require retreatment with 303 Fabric Guard to restore the water repellency
